


POWER COUNTY COMMISSIONER MINUTES

The Board of Power County Commissioners met in special session on March 6, 2001. Present were Commissioners Ken Estep, Chairman, Valerie Hoybjerg and Janet S. Chapman. Also present was Power County Clerk Christine Steinlicht.

AMERICAN LEGION BUILDING PURCHASE: American Legion Commander Gary Crane met with the Commissioners regarding a proposed purchase of the American Legion Building by Power County. Also present were Legion Members Roger Workman, Ray Workman, Pete Davis and Tom Lute, as well as Marcia Roads representing the Ladies Auxiliary. The Commissioners and Legion members discussed a possible purchase price for the building. Legion members expressed an interest in some type of land swap rather than a cash sale. Commander Crane indicated that he would make arrangements for an appraisal of the American Legion premises. The Commissioners and Clerk took a tour of the American Legion building. This matter was tabled until March 26, 2001.

WOMEN'S ADVOCACY – FAMILY SERVICES ALLIANCE: The Commissioner reviewed the proposed Memorandum of Understanding previously presented by the Family Service Alliance. Moved by Commissioner Hoybjerg, seconded by Commissioner Chapman, to approve and sign the Memorandum of Understanding as presented. Carried.
