

POWER COUNTY COMMISSIONER MINUTES

The Board of Power County Commissioners met in special session on Monday, October 29, 2001. Present were Commissioners Ken Estep, Chairman, Valerie Hoybjerg and Janet S. Chapman. Also present were Maureen Schelske, Power County Deputy Clerk, and Power County Prosecuting Attorney Paul Laggis.

EXECUTIVE SESSION: Moved by Commissioner Hoybjerg, seconded by Commissioner Chapman, to move into executive session pursuant to I.C. #67-2345, for the purpose of taking up indigent medical applications. Carried.

PLANNING & ZONING ATTORNEY FEES: The Commissioners reviewed the billing received from Attorney Guy Price for legal services rendered to the Planning & Zoning Commission and the Power County Board of Commissioners. Moved by Commissioner Estep, seconded by Commissioner Hoybjerg, that Special Prosecuting Attorney Guy R. Price be paid for forty-five hours legal services at the rate of \$75.00 per hour, for a total of \$3375.00, plus mileage expenses of \$96.00, for a total compensation of \$3471.00, which amount represents payment in full. Carried.

P&Z REZONE – JUDICIAL REVIEW: The Commissioners discussed the recent re-zone currently pending before Judge William H. Woodland on Judicial Review. Commissioner Hoybjerg indicated that she wished to discuss this matter with Lane and Clay Kendall, the applicants, and report back to the Commissions. Moved by Commissioner Chapman, seconded by Commissioner Estep, to table discussions on the Planning & Zoning Judicial Review until Wednesday, October 31, 2001, at 9:00 o'clock a.m. Carried.
