

POWER COUNTY COMMISSIONER MINUTES

The Board of Power County Commissioners met in special session on Wednesday, June 4, 2003. Present were Power County Commissioners Ken Estep, Chairman, Vicki L. Meadows and Ray Zimmerman. Also present was Power County Clerk Christine Steinlicht.

POWER COUNTY INDIGENT SERVICES: Power County Indigent Services Director Linda Annen appeared before the Commissioners to present her fiscal year 2004 budget request.

SIXTH DISTRICT RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT FACILITY: Power County Magistrate Judge Mark Beebe and Power County Juvenile Probation Officer Russ Wheatley appeared before the Commissioners to further discuss the Sixth District Residential Treatment Facility concept. Commissioner Meadows reported that she attended the Sixth District Detention Facility Board meeting and was presented with two agreements. The first agreement includes Power County as a participant and the other does not. Following discussion, the Commissioners agreed that they would rather not participate in the Sixth District Residential Treatment Facility, but would like to discuss this issue further at the Commissioners & Clerks Conference in Burley next week.

POWER COUNTY SENIOR CITIZENS CENTER: Power County Senior Citizens Board Chairman John St. Vincent appeared before the Commissioners to present the fiscal year 2004 budget request.

POWER COUNTY CLERK: Power County Clerk Christine Steinlicht appeared before the Commissioners to present her fiscal year 2004 budget requests.

POWER COUNTY COMMISSIONERS: Commissioners reviewed remaining budget requests for fiscal year 2004.

POWER COUNTY EMPLOYEE BENEFITS: The Commissioners then met with employees to answer questions and discuss employee benefits for fiscal year 2004.

CASCADE EARTH SCIENCES: Richard Gallucci of Cascade Earth Sciences appeared before the Commissioners to discuss his fiscal year 2004 budget request for landfill ground water monitoring services.
