## POWER COUNTY COMMISSIONER MINUTES

The Board of Power County Commissioners met in special session on Friday, February 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2007. Present were Commissioners Vicki Meadows, Chairman, Ken Estep and Ron Funk. Also present were Power County Clerk Christine Steinlicht and Power County Prosecuting Attorney Paul Laggis.

POWER COUNTY COURTHOUSE – SECURITY DOOR (MAGISTRATE COURT): Power County Sheriff Jim Jeffries, Deputy Sheriff Max Sprague and Deputy Sheriff/Bailiff Brian Morris appeared before the Commissioners to report that the door to the Power County Magistrate Court work area should be modified with a push button lock to enhance security. Following discussion, the Commissioners instructed Sheriff Jeffries to review the options and costs associated with upgrading to a security door and this matter was tabled until February 12<sup>th</sup>, 2007.

<u>POWER COUNTY COURTHOUSE - COURTROOM SECURITY</u>: Following discussion, it was moved by Commissioner Meadows, seconded by Commissioner Funk, to approve the quote submitted by BGM Builders in the amount of \$7,639.00 to enhance security in the Power County Courtroom. Carried.

<u>POWER COUNTY COURTHOUSE – LIGHTING (MAGISTRATE COURT)</u>: The Commissioners reviewed the quote submitted by Stro's Electric, Inc., to install additional florescent lights in the Magistrate Court work area of the Power County Courthouse. The Commissioners agreed that additional quotes should be obtained from local electrical contractors and this matter was tabled until February 12<sup>th</sup>, 2007.

Also present was Power County Disaster Services Director Di Jones who reported on the process for vendor payment and/or reimbursement on the Homeland Security Broadband and Law Enforcement grants. Following discussion, it was moved by Commissioner Estep, seconded by Commissioner Meadows, to approve and complete the computer connectivity projects as presented and amended to allow for one CAD station in the Power County Dispatch Center. Carried.
