A. NOTICES/REPORTS

1. **Landfill Update:** Landfill Department Head Craig Heward appeared before the Commission to discuss services. Mr. Heward advised that the Transfer Station job offer was not accepted by the applicant. He stated that the Transfer Station job opening will be republished in the paper starting September 19, 2018, and will run for three (3) weeks, along with signs being posted at the Landfill about the open-position.
