

POWER COUNTY COMMISSIONER MINUTES

The Board of Power County Commissioners met in special session on July 19, 1999. Present were Power County Commissioners Kent Rudeen, Chairman, Ken Estep and Valerie Hoybjerg. Also present were Power County Clerk Christine Steinlicht and County Civil Attorney Rob Naftz.

HARMS MEMORIAL HOSPITAL DISTRICT: The Commissioner reviewed the "Official Ballot" prepared and approved by the Hospital's attorney Ken McClure of Boise, Idaho.

AIRPORT LEASE (WERENKA D/B/A SUNSET AVIATION): The Commissioners met with Airport Board Member Dan Neu to review Joe Werenka's request to reduce his airport property lease payment. Following discussion between the Commissioners it was moved by Commissioner Rudeen, seconded by Commissioner Hoybjerg to deny Werenka's request for a reduction in his airport lease payment. Carried. Moved by Commissioner Hoybjerg, seconded by Commissioner Estep, to charge all County and transient sprayers \$250.00 per year to use the County pad, if they don't use pad they will not pay the fee. Carried.

AIRPORT: The Commissioners then discussed with Airport Board Member Dan Neu, Gil Vasquez's request to allow him to rent the airport house rather than taking the housing benefit for himself. The airport house is currently being occupied "rent free" by Wendell Anderson.

PUBLIC DEFENDER: Power County Clerk Christine Steinlicht will publish in the Power County Press a Call For Bids for public defender services on July 28 and August 4, with a closing date for bids of August 18, 1999.

PARKING LOT: The Commissioners reviewed Melba Ferguson's request to trim the trees on the County property adjacent to her house. Commissioner Estep will contact Top Notch Tree Service to get an estimate on the tree trimming.

BUDGET: Power County Clerk Christine Steinlicht presented the Clerk's proposed balanced budget for the Commissioner's review.

CITY/COUNTY SOLID WASTE AGREEMENT: City Council Member George Udy and City employees Jerry Giesbrecht and Ron Anderson appeared before the Commissioners to discuss the City/County Solid Waste Agreement.
