

POWER COUNTY COMMISSIONER MINUTES

The Board of Power County Commissioners met in special session on August 30, 1999. Present were Chairman Kent Rudeen, Ken Estep, and Valerie Hoybjerg. Also present was Power County Clerk Christine Steinlicht.

SOLID WASTE: Commissioner Hoybjerg presented to the Commissioners a letter she drafted to American Falls Mayor Rudeen and City Council members in response to their letter of August 23, 1999, concerning solid waste disposal fees. County Attorney Rob Naftz appeared via telephone conference call. Following discussion, the Commissioners agreed to sign the letter and distribute the same to Mayor Rudeen, the City Council members individually, City Attorney Hank Boomer and the Power County Press.

EXECUTIVE SESSION: Moved by Hoybjerg, seconded by Estep to move into executive session to discuss personnel issues. Carried.

PLANNING & ZONING FEES: Commissioner Estep reviewed with the other commissioners the planning & zoning fees assessed for commercial buildings versus agricultural buildings. The Commissioners agreed that Snake River Cattle Company's new building should be assessed fees as a commercial building rather than agricultural.
