


POWER COUNTY COMMISSIONER MINUTES

The Board of Power County Commissioners met in special session with the American Falls City Council on September 16, 1999. Present were Commissioners Kent Rudeen, Chairman, Ken Estep and Valerie Hoybjerg, along with County Clerk Christine Steinlicht. Present from the City of American Falls were Deborah Rudeen, Mayor, City Councilpersons Ray Zimmerman, Amy Wynn, Bob Brulotte and Kristen Jensen, along with Assistant Clerk Robin Herndon and City Attorney Henry Boomer.

SOLID WASTE FEES: The County and City then discussed the County's intentions to impose a solid waste disposal fee on City households and commercial business by charging the same on 1999 tax bills. The Commissioners advised the City Council that the County Resolution to impose those fees would be read, passed and approved on September 27, 1999.

CITY/COUNTY LANDFILL PROPERTY: Following discussion between the City and County officials, it was moved by Commissioner Hoybjerg, seconded by Commissioner Estep, to obtain the name of an unbiased, disinterested, certified appraiser from Power County Assessor Doug Glascock to have an appraisal done on the old landfill property and surrounding buffer zone. Carried. The Commissioners and City Council agreed to hold a joint meeting with the appraiser.
