

POWER COUNTY COMMISSIONER MINUTES

The Board of Power County Commissioners met in special session on September 17, 1999. Present were Kent Rudeen, Chairman, Ken Estep and Valerie Hoybjerg. Also present was Power County Clerk Christine Steinlicht.

**PUBLIC DEFENDER:** The Commissioners conducted interviews for public defender services effective October 1, 1999.

**SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL FEE:** Bobbie Mauch, Power County Treasurer, appeared before the Commissioners to discuss the solid waste fee for commercial businesses which are being added to the 1999 tax bills.

**SOLID WASTE RECYCLING PROGRAM:** Brian Morris, SCILD Supervisor, appeared before the Commissioners to discuss the possibility of SCILD labor managing the recycling efforts in Power County. Brian Morris will discuss the matter with Sheriff Sprague and Transfer Station Manager Craig Heward.

**LEVY CERTIFICATIONS:** Moved by Hoybjerg, seconded by Estep, to approve the Certificate of County Levies for Power County as submitted by Power County Clerk Christine Steinlicht. Carried. (SEE ATTACHED CERTIFICATE OF COUNTY LEVIES).

**BEVERAGE LICENSE:** Commissioner Rudeen then announced it was the date and time for consideration of a beverage license. Chairman Rudeen read the application into the record. There being no public objection, it was moved by Commissioner Estep, seconded by Commissioner Hoybjerg to approve beverage application for Roger Annen d/b/a Rockland Café for draught and bottled or canned beer to be consumed on the premises. Carried.

**REPRaisal:** The Commissioners reviewed the Power County Five Year Appraisal Progress Report submitted by Alex Chizewsky of the Idaho State Tax Commission.

**DISASTER SERVICES:** Mark Love, Power County Disaster Services Director, appeared before the Commissioners to discuss placing a new container type storage building for the Rockland repeater. Mark would like to purchase the new controller out of the FY 1999 disaster services budget. Following discussions, it was decided by the Commissioners that the storage building would be purchased from the FY 2000 PILT budget.


AMBULANCE: Moved by Commissioner Rudeen, seconded by Commissioner Hoybjerg, to recess as Board of Power County Commissioners and reconvene as Power County Ambulance District Board. Carried.

Mark Love indicated that since he and other EMT's had obtained advanced certification through the State of Idaho, there is no longer a need to contract with Harms Memorial Hospital to provide Registered Nurses for "nurse on board" runs. The Commissioners agreed that the County would no longer pay Harms Memorial Hospital for "nurse on board" runs.

Moved by Commissioner Hoybjerg, seconded by Commissioner Rudeen, to recess from Ambulance District Board and reconvene as Board of Power County Commissioners. Carried.
