

POWER COUNTY COMMISSIONER MINUTES

The Board of Power County Commissioners met in special session on April 13, 2000. Present were Power County Commissioners Kent Rudeen, Chairman, Ken Estep and Valerie Hoybjerg. Also present was Power County Clerk Christine Steinlicht.

CITY/COUNTY LAW ENFORCEMENT AGREEMENT: Following discussion and a review of the figures provided by the County Sheriff and Police Chief Hubbs, it was moved by Commissioner Hoybjerg, seconded by Commissioner Estep, to charge the City of American Falls \$44,000 for Fiscal Year 2001, \$49,500 for Fiscal Year 2002, and \$50,000 for Fiscal Years 2003, 2004, and 2005, in exchange for the County providing complete and total dispatch services. Carried. Commissioner Rudeen will draft a letter to the City of American Falls.

WEED AGREEMENT: Moved by Commissioner Estep, seconded by Commissioner Rudeen, to approve and sign the Agreement for Noxious Weed Control between Power County and Idaho Transportation Department. Carried. The original will be returned to the Department of Transportation for their signature.

SOIL CONSERVATION DISTRICT: Moved by Commissioner Estep, seconded by Commissioner Hoybjerg, to send a letter of intent to budget \$4,000 for the Power County Soil Conservation District from the County's Fiscal Year 2001 budget. Carried.

EXECUTIVE SESSION: Moved by Commissioner Estep, seconded by Commissioner Hoybjerg, to move into executive session for the purpose of taking up personnel issues. Carried.

PROPERTY LINE FENCE: The Commissioners then reviewed a request by adjacent property owner Melba Ferguson for a privacy fence between the County property and her private property. The Commissioners will review the available options.
