


POWER COUNTY COMMISSIONER MINUTES


The Board of Power County Commissioners met in special session on May 15, 2000. Present were Kent Rudeen, Chairman, Ken Estep and Valerie Hoybjerg. Also present were Power County Clerk Christine Steinlicht and Power County Civil Attorney Rob Naftz.

ASTARIS (FORMER FMC): Astaris, formerly FMC, hosted a lunch and tour for the Power County Elected Officials and the Power County Industrial Development Board. Those attending from Power County were Commissioners Kent Rudeen, Ken Estep and Valerie Hoybjerg, Power County Clerk Steinlicht, Power County Assessor Doug Glascock and Deputy Assessor Mary Annen, Power County Sheriff Howard Sprague and Power County Industrial Development Board members Grant Neibuar, Otto Tiede and Dan Hammond. Arlen Whitrock advised the County officials that Astaris property taxes will continue to be paid by FMC Corporation, a parent company of Astaris.

CITY/COUNTY LAW ENFORCEMENT AGREEMENT: Following a discussion at the Commissioners Chambers, the Commissioners authorized County Civil Attorney Rob Naftz and Power County Prosecuting Attorney Paul Laggis to meet with City Attorney Henry R. Boomer in an attempt to resolve the issue of whether the County can legally charge the City of American Falls for dispatch services.
