


POWER COUNTY COMMISSIONER MINUTES

The Board of Power County Commissioners met in special session with the American Falls Mayor and City Council on Wednesday, October 18, 2000. Present were Commissioners Kent Rudeen, Chairman, Ken Estep and Valerie Hoybjerg. Also present were Power County Clerk Christine Steinlicht and Power County Prosecuting Attorney Paul Laggis.

CITY/COUNTY LAW ENFORCEMENT AGREEMENT: Pursuant to the agreements reached at mediation, the Commissioners and City Council conducted its first joint quarterly meeting. Present from the City of American Falls were Mayor Deborah Rudeen, Council Members Amy Wynn, George Udy, Ray Zimmerman, Afton Jacobson, Kristen Jensen and Nate Covington. Also present were City Attorney Henry R. Boomer, City Resource Coordinator Jerrie Boyce, Deputy City Clerk Robin Herndon, American Falls Police Chief Jerry Hubbs and Lt. Jim Morse. At the outset, those present reviewed the County's written proposal for RAS (Remote Access Software) which would allow the City to dial directly to the County server and access the Sheriff's database just like another work station. The City will discuss connectivity with their technical support staff and submit their written proposal to the County, after which both options could be considered prior to finalizing the connectivity. County and City officials then toured the dispatch center at the Power County Sheriff's Office. The next joint meeting will be held on December 6, 2000, at 6:00 o'clock p.m. at the City of American Falls Council Chambers.
