

## POWER COUNTY COMMISSIONER MINUTES

The Board of Power County Commissioners met in regular session on November 20, 2000. Present were Commissioners Kent Rudeen, Chairman, Ken Estep and Valerie Hoybjerg. Also present were Power County Clerk Christine Steinlicht and Prosecuting Attorney Paul Laggis.

**COMMISSIONER COMMITTEE ASSIGNMENTS:** The Commissioners discussed possible Commissioner committee appointments to be made in January, 2001.

**SOUTHEASTERN DISTRICT HEALTH DEPARTMENT:** Commissioner Hoybjerg reported that the Southeastern District Health Department is short on flu shots and will be initially allowing only "high risk" residents to obtain flu shots. Following a review of the Billing Agreement for Services received from the Southeastern District Health Department, it was moved by Commissioner Rudeen, seconded by Commissioner Estep, to provide flu shots to County employees, at County expense (\$10 per shot), when and if extra flu shots become available. Carried.

**AMERICAN FALLS RURAL FIRE DISTRICT (EXTRICATION AGREEMENT):** The Commissioner reviewed the proposed Extrication Agreement between Power County and the American Falls Rural Fire District for extrication services, which was prepared by Power County Prosecuting Attorney Paul Laggis. Moved by Commissioner Hoybjerg, seconded by Commissioner Estep, to approve the agreement as presented. Carried.

**POWER COUNTY SHERIFF TOWING POLICY:** Power County Sheriff Howard Sprague and Chief Deputy Sheriff Jim Jeffries appeared before the Commissioners to review the proposed vehicle tow policy prepared by Power County Prosecuting Attorney Paul Laggis. This matter was tabled until November 27, 2000.

**CHRISTMAS PARTY:** Following discussion, it was agreed that Power County purchase pens for County employees and volunteers for Christmas. Clerk Steinlicht placed the order for the pens, which should be filled by December 15<sup>th</sup>, 2000. The Christmas party is scheduled for December 2, 2000, beginning at 5:00 o'clock p.m. with the City of American Falls. City Council Member Amy Wynn and Power County Clerk Steinlicht will make arrangements for the meat, rolls, plates, cups, utensils, and punch, which will be provided by the City and County. Clerk Steinlicht will contact SCILD Supervisor Brian Morris to request that SCILD labor set up the EMS Building for the joint Christmas party.

**SEARCH & RESCUE BUILDING:** Commissioners reviewed the quotes submitted by for electrical work which needs to be done at the new Power County Search & Rescue Building.
