

## POWER COUNTY COMMISSIONER MINUTES

The Board of Power County Commissioners met in special session on December 28, 2000. Present were Commissioners Kent Rudeen, Chairman, Ken Estep and Valerie Hoybjerg. Also present was Power County Clerk Christine Steinlicht.

BEVERAGE LICENSES: Commissioner Rudeen announced that it was the time and date set for consideration of numerous beverage licenses. Commissioner Rudeen read the applications into the record. There being no public objection, it was moved by Commissioner Estep, seconded by Commissioner Hoybjerg, that the following beverage licenses be approved.

1. Amend Retail Alcoholic Beverage License of Rachel Torres d/b/a Lish's Bar, for the sale of draught and bottled or canned beer to be consumed on the premises.
2. Melinda Wilkes d/b/a Little Bargain Barn for the sale of bottled or canned beer not to be consumed on the premises and retail wine.
3. Brenda Nichols d/b/a Stardust Lounge for draught and bottled or canned beer to be consumed on the premises and retail liquor.
4. Sylvia Alicia Gutierrez d/b/a LaRancherita Mexican Imports for the sale of bottled or canned beer not to be consumed on the premises.
5. Sandra Tomlinson d/b/a Hi-Lo Club for the sale of draught and bottled or canned beer to be consumed on the premises.

Motion carried.

CLAIMS: moved By Commissioner Hoybjerg, seconded by Commissioner Rudeen, to approve the claims as presented. Carried.

HARDSHIP EXEMPTION: The Commissioners then reviewed the Hardship Exemption Application of Sharon Morse. Ms. Morse has requested that the Commissioner forgive the real and personal property taxes owing for the year 2000, which total \$293.38. Moved by Commissioner Hoybjerg, seconded by Commissioner Estep, to forgive \$146.69 of the year 2000 real and personal property taxes owing by Sharon Morse, which is equivalent to one-half of the total amount owing from July, 2000 through December, 2000. Carried.

AMBULANCE: Moved by Commissioner Rudeen, seconded by Commissioner Hoybjerg, to recess as Power County Board of Commissioners and reconvene as Power County Ambulance District Board. Carried.

Emergency Services Director Mark Love appeared before the Commissioners to discuss a grant he has received in the amount of \$2,673 to be used for education and recertification of emergency medical technicians.

Moved by Commissioner Rudeen, seconded by Commissioner Estep, to recess as Power County Ambulance District Board and reconvene as Power County Board of Commissioners. Carried.

BUILDING ADMINISTRATOR: Commissioner Estep reported that Power County Building Administrator Richard Wiles has earned certification through the State of Idaho. The Commissioners then discussed additional compensation for Mr. Wiles since he has completed State Certification. Moved by Commissioner Estep, seconded by Commissioner Hoybjerg, to increase Richard Wiles' salary to \$25,900. Carried.
