

POWER COUNTY COMMISSIONER MINUTES

The Board of Power County Commissioners met in special session on August 21, 2001. Present were Commissioners Ken Estep, Chairman, Valerie Hoybjerg and Janet S. Chapman. Also present was Power County Clerk Christine Steinlicht.

ANIMAL CONTROL BOARD: Moved by Commissioner Estep, seconded by Commissioner Chapman, to appoint Vernon Miller as director from Power County to the District #4 Animal Control Board. Carried.

POWER COUNTY WEB PAGE: Moved by Commissioner Chapman, seconded by Commissioner Estep, to approve the quote submitted by Trish Gutierrez of Surf the Snake to construct and maintain a web page for Power County. Carried.

ICRMP – LOSS CONTROL VISIT: Clerk Steinlicht reported that Gary Gunderson from ICRMP will visit Power County on Tuesday, September 4, 2001, at 10:00 o'clock a.m. to review Power County's liability insurance policy and to discuss loss control. The Commissioners and other elected officials are invited to attend.

COLLEGE OF SOUTHERN IDAHO – CERTIFICATE OF RESIDENCY: Moved by Commissioner Chapman, seconded by Commissioner Estep, to approve the certificate of residency of Armentha K. West to attend the College of Southern Idaho in Twin Falls. Carried.

INDEPENDENT AUDITOR – LETTER OF UNDERSTANDING: Moved by Commissioner Estep, seconded by Commissioner Chapman, to approve and sign the Letter of Understanding between Power County and Scott Jones, CPA, of the firm Jones, Yost, Hatt, Erickson P.A., to examine the financial statements of Power County for the period October 1, 2000, through September 30, 2001, with the fees for such service not to exceed \$4,200. Carried.

STATE BOARD OF TAX APPEALS: Clerk Steinlicht reported that Claudia J. Walter d/b/a Pocatello Speedway, Inc., has filed a Notice of Appeal before the Idaho State Board of Tax Appeals. Power County Assessor Doug Glascock appeared before the Commissioners to discuss the procedure for hearing appeals by the Idaho State Board of Tax Appeals.

POWER COUNTY TREASURER – PENDING ISSUES: Power County Treasurer Bobbie Mauch appeared before the Commissioners and presented a list of pending issues for taxes owing from 1995 through 1998. Treasurer Mauch indicated that she would keep the Commissioners advised in the event she finds it necessary to take possession of property.

EXECUTIVE SESSION: Moved by Commissioner Hoybjerg, seconded by Commissioner Estep, to move into executive session pursuant to I.C. #67-2345, for the purpose of taking up personnel issues and potential legal issues. Carried.

COMMISSIONER REDISTRICTING: The Commissioners reviewed census population figures by voting precincts and discussed a plan to equalize the population between Commissioner Districts. Clerk Steinlicht will prepare a proposed map for the Commissioners review.
