The Board of Power County Commissioners met in special session on September 5, 2001. Present were Commissioners Ken Estep, Chairman, Valerie Hoybjerg and Janet S. Chapman. Also present was Power County Clerk Christine Steinlicht.


JUVENILE DETENTION AGREEMENT (MINI-CASSIA): Moved by Commissioner Estep, seconded by Commissioner Hoybjerg, to approve and sign the juvenile detention agreement between Power County and the Mini-Cassia Juvenile Detention Center. Carried.

WEED MANAGEMENT AGREEMENT: Following a review of the proposed agreement, it was moved by Commissioner Estep, seconded by Commissioner Hoybjerg, to approve the Portneuf Valley Cooperative Weed Management Agreement as presented. Carried.

PUBLIC RECORDS COPYING FEE: The Commissioners discussed assessing a fee for providing the public with copies of taped public hearings. The Commissioners agreed that an appropriate fee would be \$20.00 per tape. Prosecuting Attorney Laggis will prepare a proposed fee resolution to implement this fee, which will be published in accordance with Idaho Law and set for public hearing.

CRATERS OF THE MOON NATIONAL MONUMENT – LAW ENFORCEMENT ASSISTANCE AGREEMENT: The Commissioners reviewed the proposed law enforcement assistance agreement between Power County and the United States Department of Interior, Bureau of Land Management, for law enforcement services in the Power County area of the Craters of the Moon National Monument. Moved by Commissioner Hoybjerg, seconded by Commissioner Chapman, to approve the Craters of the Moon National Monument Law Enforcement Assistance Agreement as presented and amended (half of the original page four and half of original page five were deleted and replaced with an amended page six which was faxed to Power County by the Bureau of Land Management. Also the original page thirteen was replaced with a new page thirteen). Carried.
