


**POWER COUNTY COMMISSIONER MINUTES**


The Board of Power County Commissioners met in special session on Tuesday, November 20, 2001. Present were Commissioners Ken Estep, Chairman, Janet S. Chapman and Valerie Hoybjerg. Also present was Power County Clerk Christine Steinlicht.

PLANNING & ZONING MORATORIUM RESOLUTION: The Commissioners reviewed a proposed Resolution prepared by Power County Special Planning & Zoning Attorney Jerry Mason. The proposed Resolution provides for a moratorium period on the acceptance, review and granting of permits for electric generating plants, since the current Power County Zoning Ordinance may not adequately address the methods of analysis, the standards for development or the appropriate locational criteria for such proposal. The Commissioners discussed the proposed moratorium with Industrial Development Board Secretary John Hoybjerg. Following discussion, Mr. Hoybjerg indicated that the Industrial Development Board would attempt to contact all potential developers and let them know that the proposed moratorium is for clean up of County ordinance only and not an attempt to discourage industrial development. The Commissioners agreed that this issue requires further discussion.

IAC FIFTH DISTRICT ELECTED OFFICIALS MEETING: The Commissioners and Clerk attended the IAC Fifth District Elected Officials meeting in Pocatello at 1:30 p.m.
