

POWER COUNTY COMMISSIONER MINUTES

The Board of Power County Commissioners met in regular session on Monday, August 2nd, 2004. Present were Commissioners Ken Estep, Chairman, and Vicki L. Meadows. Also present were Power County Clerk Christine Steinlicht and Power County Prosecuting Attorney Paul Laggis.

ALCOHOL BEVERAGE LICENSES: (#10:17:01) Commissioner Estep reported that it was the date and time scheduled for consideration of a number of alcohol beverage licenses. There being no public objection, it was moved by Commissioner Meadows, seconded by Commissioner Estep, to approve the following alcohol beverage licenses:

1. Bill L. Beck d/b/a Bill's Pro Shop for the sale of bottled or canned beer to be consumed on the premises and retail wine.
2. James Udy d/b/a Mr. Petrol's Pantry for the sale of bottled or canned beer not to be consumed on the premises and retail wine.
3. Claudia J. Walters d/b/a Pocatello Speedway, Inc. for the sale of bottled or canned beer to be consumed on the premises.

FISCAL YEAR 2005 BUDGET – COMMISSIONERS APPROVED: Clerk Steinlicht presented the final draft fiscal year 2005 Budget. Following discussion, it was moved by Commissioner Estep, seconded by Commissioner Meadows, to publish the proposed final budget in the August 11th and 18th editions of the Power County Press. Carried. Public hearing on the proposed budget is scheduled for Monday, August 23rd, 2004, at 6:00 p.m. in the Commissioners Office of the Power County Courthouse.

EXECUTIVE SESSION (I.C. #67-2345): Moved by Commissioner Estep, seconded by Commissioner Meadows, to move into executive session pursuant to I.C. #67-2345 for the purpose of taking up indigent medical applications. Carried.

INDIGENT CASE #2004-16-I: Moved by Commissioner Meadows, seconded by Commissioner Estep, to approve indigent application #2004-16-I. Carried.

POWER COUNTY JAIL – QUARTERLY JAIL INSPECTION: The Commissioners then conducted their quarterly inspection of the Power County Jail.
