The Board of Power County Commissioners met in special session with the American Falls Mayor and City Council on Wednesday, November 8th, 2006. GREAT RIFT BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT ORGANIZATION: American Falls City Council Member Dan Hammond reported that the Great Rift Business Development Organization Board has adopted By-laws, approved a proposed budget and entered into Mutual Aid Agreements with the City of Aberdeen, City of American Falls, Bingham and Power Counties to hire an economic development coordinator pursuant to the Idaho Department of Commerce Economic Development Agency (EDA) grant. Mr. Hammond then indicated that the business office of the Great Rift Business Development Organization will be located in the American Falls City Hall.


CITY OF AMERICAN FALLS – CHIEF OF POLICE AGREEMENT: American Falls Mayor Amy Wynn reported that she and the City Council have been involved in the process of hiring a chief of police prior to the expiration of the Agreement between Power County and the City of American Falls, or November 15th, 2006. Also present were Power County Sheriff/Chief of Police Jim Jeffries and Chief Deputy Sheriff Jackie Morris. Following discussion, the Commissioners and the American Falls City Council agreed to table further discussion of this matter until Monday, November 13th, 2006, at 6:00 p.m.

EXECUTIVE SESSION (I.C. #67-2345): Moved by Commissioner Meadows, seconded by Commissioner Estep, to move into executive session pursuant to I.C. #67-2345 for the purpose of taking up personnel issues. Carried.

POWER COUNTY BOARD OF CANVASSERS (I.C. #34-1205) – 2006 GENERAL ELECTION CANVASS: The Board of Power County Commissioners then met as the Power County Board of Canvassers pursuant to I.C. #34-1205. Following discussion, it was moved by Commissioner Estep, seconded by Commissioner Zimmerman, to approve

and certify the 2006 General Election results as presented by Power County Clerk
