


**POWER COUNTY COMMISSIONER MINUTES**


The Board of Power County Commissioners met in special session on Friday, December 14<sup>th</sup>, 2007. Present were Commissioners Vicki Meadows, Chairman, Ken Estep and Ron Funk. Also present was Power County Clerk Christine Steinlicht.

SIXTH DISTRICT JUVENILE DETENTION CENTER – BED SPACE ALLOCATION: Commissioner Meadows reported that she had attended the most recent meeting of the Sixth District Regional Detention Center Board, and that the Detention Center Board is considering expanding the current facility from 16 to 32 beds at an estimated cost of \$1.7 million. Commissioner Meadows further reported that Bear Lake County has expressed an interest in selling Power County one-half of a bed at the Sixth District Juvenile Detention Center. Following discussion, the Commissioners agreed to discuss this matter further with the Bear Lake County Board of Commissioners on Monday, December 17<sup>th</sup>, 2007, at 9:15 a.m., and this matter was tabled until that time.

3-B JUVENILE DETENTION CENTER – JUVENILE TRANSPORTS: Power County Sheriff Jim Jeffries appeared before the Commissioners to discuss the Agreement between Power County and 3-B Juvenile Detention Center in Idaho Falls to temporarily house Power County's non-status Juvenile offenders. Also present was Power County Juvenile Probation Office Supervisor Connie Shepherd. Sheriff Jeffries reported that the frequency of trips back and forth from Idaho Falls to transport Juveniles who have been "bumped" from the 3-B facility is creating a financial hardship for the Power County Sheriff's Office.
