The Board of Power County Commissioners met in special session on Tuesday, July 6th, 2010. Present were Commissioners Ken Estep and Ron Funk. Also present was Power County Clerk Christine Steinlicht.

SHOSHONE-BANNOCK TRIBES – SOIL CLEANUP STANDARDS FOR CONTAMINATED PROPERTIES (RESOLUTION #2010-09): Following discussion with Power County Special Attorney Douglas J. Balfour, it was moved by Commissioner Estep, seconded by Commissioner Funk, to approve and execute Power County Resolution #2010-09 authorizing comments to the Shoshone-Bannock Tribes on the Soil Cleanup Standards for contaminated properties. Carried.

UTILITY TRANSMISSION LINES – MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING: The Commissioners contacted the Bingham and Cassia County Commissioners by telephone to discuss the provisions of the Memorandum of Understanding which would allow Power, Cassia and Bingham Counties to share the legal costs of pursuing common interests and goals in the enforcement of the Counties' responsibilities under the Idaho Land Use Planning Act concerning the siting of utility transmission corridors. Following discussion, the Commissioners agreed to table further consideration of this matter until July 26th, 2010.
