III. AGENDA

A. NOTICES/REPORTS

1. **Adult Probation Update:** Wade Dishion from Misdemeanor Probation provided an update for the 1st quarter of 2021. Mr. Dishion advised Amy Hillyer will attend the academy on July 6, 2021 for 3 1/2 weeks which includes graduation. Mr. Dishion advised they have 24 active probation cases and advised the average cost of supervision was \$2,225.63 per month for all the attendees. Mr. Dishion advised he is scheduled on June 30, 2021 for the budget hearing. Mr. Dishion advised he would like the stipend to remain the same as last year with at \$1,000 a month.
2. **District 6 Detention Update:** Commissioner Lasley provided an update to the Commission on a Juvenile Detention Board Meeting he attended on June 3, 2021. Commissioner Lasley advised that at that meeting CARES funding, budget presentation and Joint Power Agreement were discussed.
3. **Juvenile Probation Update/Budget Hearing:** Connie Woodworth, Juvenile Justice Administrator advised the Juvenile Probation van has been needing jump started due to not being driven as often.

Ms. Woodworth advised she has 22 juveniles on probation; 6 girls and 16 boys. Ms. Woodworth advised summer school starts July 5, 2021. Ms. Woodworth advised 3 juveniles graduated from High School. Ms. Woodworth advised she is still doing safety meetings once a month in her office.

Ms. Woodworth advised that she would like to freeze \$1,000 of pretrial release for the 2022 budget.

Ms. Woodworth advised her date of retirement is June 1, 2022, but advised if the employee that fills her position is not Police Officer Standards and Training (POST) certified she can retire later than June 1, 2022. Commissioner Funk advised he would like the job opening posted in January and advised he would like the new hire to train with Ms. Woodworth for 3 months.

4. **Idaho Department of Environmental Quality (IDEQ):** Bruce Olenick, Department of Environmental Quality appeared before the Commission and provided a quarterly update. Mr. Olenick advised he will be retiring in August. Mr. Olenick advised he can't tell which way the ground water is moving with the 2 wells at the Landfill because there needs to be 3 wells. Mr. Olenick advised they are providing a Ground Monitoring 101 Class.
5. **Landfill Update:** Jeff Rankin, Landfill Supervisor advised Xcell provided a copy of their proposal for the operation modifications to the Power County Landfill and advised they would like to meet with the Commission and DEQ in the near future.
